If you are looking for volunteer hours, we need people to come volunteer to work the gate at the shows. Paige just learned that our June judge has a conflict, so she will work on finding a new one. Julie and Anita had a suggestion for her.

For old business: Susan asked about exhibition runs - before vs. after the class. We reviewed that the decision was to continue to run them at the beginning of the class, but that the cost isn't included in the member cap.

For new business: It was brought to the attention of the gymkhana managers that at the May gymkhana a member was rude to the royalty and the photographer who was there to take pictures. If this happens in the future, that person will be asked to leave for the day. As a reminder, the warm-up area is for warming up. There are many other people and horses so walking, trotting, and maybe loping are permissible, but there should be no running of horses, or anything that puts others at risk.
