Amy bought up being mindful of the spacing of the horses in the parade. Reminder, only Royalty will be riding in the *Greeley* Stampede Parade.

Gymkhana Report: Discussion was had that we need people to step up and help announce and work the gates. Britany offered to help with announcing and Jen mentioned that she could create a signup genius so we will know ahead of time if those items are covered. A concern was brought up of people riding fast up and down the aisles of the parking area. This is a hazard as people may not see those riders. A sign will be created and an announcement made at the start of the gymkhana so people are aware.

Show Report: Chuck Mangan and Beth Smith will be our judges; this will be a double judged show for the members to make up for the May cancellation. If you want to receive credit for each judge, you will need to pay two class fees. Show patterns will be the same ones we were going to use in May, and they are posted on the web.

Old Business: Reminder that Amy and Gwen will be doing a Drill Team clinic at the T S Ranch on June 25^{th} . The clinic will start at 10:00 am and is free. It will cover things such as the holding of flags and hat etiquette along with other drill team requirements.

New Business: Nothing to report.
