

Johnstown Saddle Club May 1, 2021 Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm.

Roll call of officers: Paige, Denise and Leslie were in attendance.

Secretary's report: The March 6th and April 3rd minutes were approved as read.

Treasurer's report for April was giving by Paige - The Royalty has \$496.83 in their account after receiving an invoice for \$191.06 for the purchase of shirts. We have \$2,705.87 in checking after paying Joslin \$334.97 for daily highpoints, \$2,000 to Susan for the arena rental, \$50 for Patterns.com for our shows, \$191.06 for Royalty shirts and \$647.32 to Hodges Badges for purchase of ribbons. We have \$2,552.87 in Savings after receiving .13 cents in interest, giving us a total balance of \$5,258.74.

Royalty report: Royalty discussed doing a fun show later in the year and was there any interest? After discussion it was decided to hold the Royalty Fun Show on August 15th. Sheridan reported on the Instagram page and mentioned the Royalty photos. Paige stated that the photo shoot turned out great and that many of the photos can be used to help promote the royalty.

Gymkhana report: Paige mentioned that we will need an announcer for the event. Joslin will check with Ann Marie as she has announced before. Paige also mentioned that we will have a photographer at this event and she will have photos for purchase. Melissa brought up that we could put a Gymkhana judge in place to help the announcer and to get someone else volunteer hours. It was decided to put this into place at the next event. It was also mentioned that we may want to get walkie/talkies so the gate can communicate with the announcers booth. Paige mentioned that Susan will not have concessions and Mandy stated that the Royalty could have water, gatoraid and chips for sale at the booth.

Show Report: Paige mentioned that Teaghan Weir will be our first judge. Patterns were discussed and they will be posted on Facebook and on our web page so people can view them.

Old Business: Paige did a recap of clean up day and she announced that it was the best turn out in recent memory and thanked those members for helping out. Paige next brought up that Jim Hitt, one of our judges, is still willing to run a Trail clinic or possibly a Ranch Horse clinic. It was decided that June 13th would be the best day for that. Rockie brought forward more information about the possible building raffle, which would be a 12 X 20 barn which is valued at \$5,200. We could look at selling tickets for \$10 each. Concerns were brought up about Colorado State laws and what would we need to follow? It was decided we need to look further into the regulations so we will table for a future meeting.
