### **Treasurer's Report:**

**March:** The club began the month with \$2192.51 in checking and had 1 deposit totaling \$150.00. There were 11 withdrawals totaling \$1011.34, leaving an ending balance in checking of \$1331.17. In savings the beginning balance was \$3160.57. There were two deposits totaling \$3160.57 and no withdrawals, leaving the club with an ending balance of \$6662.42 in savings. The club had a total ending balance of \$7993.59. Royalty began the month with \$545.82 in checking and had 3 deposits totaling \$1660.00. They also had 14 withdrawals totaling \$1549.13, leaving them with an ending balance of \$662.69 in checking. In savings, royalty began with \$2226.76. They had 3 deposits totaling \$840.87, and 3 withdrawals \$1666.00, leaving and ending balance of \$1401.63 in royalty savings. Royalty ended with a total ending balance of \$2064.32.
