The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm.

Roll call of officers: The Secretary was present and acted as the presiding officer.

Secretary's report: January's minutes were approved as read.

Treasurer's report – January's report – We started with \$695.93 in Checking; we had three deposits totaling \$2,263.00 and three withdrawals totaling \$263.55 giving us an ending balance of \$2,695.38. We started with \$1,502.55 in Savings; we had three deposits totaling 1,100.66 giving us an ending balance of \$2,603.21. The total club balance was \$5,298.59. The Royalty checking account had a beginning balance of \$229.10, they had three deposits totaling 1,150.00 and six withdrawals totaling \$1,149.87 giving them a final total of \$229.23. In their Savings they had a beginning balance of \$3,345.53. They had two deposits totaling \$2851.87 and three withdrawals totaling \$470.00 giving them an ending balance of \$4,327.40. The total balance of their two accounts was \$4,556.63.

New Business: Leslie covered the discussion of the Turquoise Trail Show to be held at the Boulder County Fairgrounds on July 18th and 19th. This show does not count towards the Show Buckle series. Items covered were:

- July 18th will be English and Western Classes, English will consist of Showmanship, Equitation, Show Hack and Hunter Hack. Western will consist of Showmanship, Horsemanship, Western Pleasure and Reining.
- July 19th will be Ranch classes consisting of Performance Halter, Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding and Ranch Reining.
- Classes will be run as Leadline, Walk/Trot/Jog 12 & Under, Junior Exhibitor, Adult Amateur, and Open (all ages).
- Proposed \$15 per class, \$10 office fee, offering day stall at \$20 or overnight stalls at \$30.
- Will look at obtaining a food truck as we are not a licensed food vendor.

We will be doing a Butterbraids fundraiser the first part of March with a goal of raising \$2,500. Jen Rajewski to report more at our March meeting.

It was reported that BKK Jolly Ranch and Into the Storm Equipment Rental has committed to saddle sponsorships for 2026. The Davies also mentioned their willingness to sponsor once again.
