

Johnstown Saddle Club July 10, 2026 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 pm.

Roll call of officers: All officers were present.

Secretary's report: June's minutes were approved as read.

Treasurer's report – June's report – We started with \$2,432.37 in Checking; we had two deposits totaling \$4,643.00 and fifteen withdrawals totaling \$4,089.23 giving us an ending balance of \$2,986.14. We started with \$12,999.88 in Savings; we had three deposits totaling \$861.03 and one withdrawal totaling \$3,000.00 giving us an ending balance of \$10,860.91. The total club balance is \$13,847.05.

The Royalty checking account had a beginning balance of \$888.50; they had three withdrawals for \$357.97 giving them a final total of \$530.53. In their Savings they had a beginning balance of \$6,180.74. They had one interest deposit for \$4.65 giving them an ending balance of \$6,185.39. The total balance of their two accounts is \$6,715.92.

Show Report: The show went well, our judge, Cody Roth, did a great job. Teagan Weir will be the July judge, and he will need a scribe as he cut a tendon. A clarification was made regarding Ranch Trail pattern as it indicated the W/T pattern for the older groups. A lope has been added to correct the pattern. We will be adding a pre-loading section to make the show go faster. We will also be handing out ribbons to everyone, and people can turn them in for bucks afterwards if they wish.

Gymkhana Report: The last Gymkhana went smoothly and there were more participants. Reminder for the July Gymkhana to bring water and stay hydrated. Consider bringing electrolytes for the horses.

Like the show, we will do a pre-load area. Kari mentioned the canopies are set up, and we will need help putting up the tarps.

Reminder that tank tops can be worn but the straps need to be 2 fingers wide.

Bow-tie will be the pattern for this Gymkhana.

Royalty report: The Royalty reported on the Rooftop Parade and luncheon where they met Lindsey Fancher Rule. The Royalty Pageant will be held in August for anyone interested.

Deb is stepping down as the coordinator and there has been a revamping of the program to add a royalty parent. The applications for the junior and senior royalty have been changed.

Deb was thanked for her service and increasing the Royalty presence.
