

Johnstown Saddle Club June 12, 2026 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm.

Roll call of officers: All officers were present.

Secretary's report: May's minutes were approved as read.

Treasurer's report – May's report – We started with \$5,019.98 in Checking; we had two deposits totaling \$4,407.00 and fourteen withdrawals totaling \$6,994.61 giving us an ending balance of \$2,432.37. We started with \$12,909.77 in Savings; we had four deposits totaling \$2,090.11 and two withdrawals totaling \$2,000.00 giving us an ending balance of \$12,999.88. The total club balance was \$15,432.25.

The Royalty checking account had a beginning balance of \$934.59; they had one withdrawal for \$46.10 giving them a final total of \$888.50. In their Savings they had a beginning balance of \$6,180.74. They had one interest deposit for \$2.36 giving them an ending balance of \$6,183.10. The total balance of their two accounts was \$7,071.60.

Show Report: Things at our last show ran smoothly, especially the Trail set up. Cody Roth will be our Judge for June. A clarification was made regarding Ranch Trail pattern, only Adults will be picking up the slicker.

Gymkhana Report: We had great volunteers and the new event addition went well. We did not have a huge crowd which was a plus in that it allowed for a faster day and got us out of the heat earlier.

Kari mentioned that water was placed on the arena and it should be in good condition for the weekend's events.

Royalty report: The Royalty reported on the Berthoud Day Parade and mentioned what a hit the pony was in drawing attention to the club. There was quite a bit of traffic at the booth and the Royalty talked with a lot of people. It was reported that Addison Lambert was in a bicycle accident and to keep her in your prayers.

Old Business:

- The JSC booth at Berthoud Day went over well and we had a lot of traffic.
- Only three people besides Royalty were in the parade, as a reminder, people can ride in the truck if you don't want to ride a horse. This is a great way to get in your hours.
