The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm.

Roll call of officers: All officers present except for the Vice President, Casey Goree.

Secretary's report: February's minutes were approved as read.

Treasurer's report – February's report – We started with \$2,695.38 in Checking; we had no deposits and two withdrawals totaling \$92.00 giving us an ending balance of \$2,603.38. We started with \$2,603.21 in Savings; we had five deposits totaling 3,287.71 and one withdrawal of 260.00 giving us an ending balance of \$5,630.92. The total club balance was \$8,234.30. The Royalty checking account had a beginning balance of \$229.23, they had one deposit totaling 1,000.00 and four withdrawals totaling \$953.70 giving them a final total of \$275.33. In their Savings they had a beginning balance of \$4,327.40. They had three deposits totaling \$761.32 and one withdrawal totaling \$1,000.00 giving them an ending balance of \$4,088.72. The total balance of their two accounts was \$4,364.25.
