

Johnstown Saddle Club May 1, 2026 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm.

Roll call of officers: The Vice President was absent.

Secretary's report: April's minutes were approved as read.

Show Report: A clarification was made on the Leadline and W/T Ranch Trail pattern, there is no side pass, that is being removed.

Gymkhana Report: Nothing to report.

Treasurer's report – April's report – We started with \$2,096.97 in Checking; we had three deposits totaling \$6,434.20 and sixteen withdrawals totaling \$3,511.19 giving us an ending balance of \$5,019.98. We started with \$6,633.26 in Savings; we had eight deposits totaling \$10,776.51 and two withdrawals totaling \$4,500.00 giving us an ending balance of \$12,909.77. The total club balance was \$17,929.75.

The Royalty checking account had a beginning balance of \$295.00; they had two deposits for \$1,555.00 and nine withdrawals for \$915.41 giving them a final total of \$934.59. In their Savings they had a beginning balance of \$3,900.26. They had four deposits totaling \$3,835.48 and two withdrawals totaling \$1,555.00 giving them an ending balance of \$6,180.74. The total balance of their two accounts was \$7,115.33.

Royalty report: Emma reported on the April Glitz and Glam Gymkhana Event in which there were 45 participants. \$3,084.00 was raised and it was a very successful event. Reminder that Royalty will be doing their Grand Entry at the Gymkhana.

- A 4th saddle is now sponsored for the Gymkhana by the Davies. The following age groups have saddles 8 & Under, 9-11, 12-14 and 15-19.
- Fusion Field Service is providing us with porta potties.
- All members need to sign the form that they have read the bylaws and rules. Both of these documents exist on the website.
- Berthoud Day – Jen is the contact for the parade. We will have a booth at Berthoud Day and members can help out. We will have some giveaways to entice people to stop by and chat with us.
- La Casita will not be at this month's gymkhana; Deb did find a replacement food truck for us.
- The Rebel Riders from Arvada came to the Glitz and Glam to support us, it is encouraged that we support their gymkhana events if possible.
- The Royalty Roost will be set up by the gate for ribbons and buck pick up.
